

The Risk-Peril:

Sin has separated us from God and if we face His condemnation and judgment, we are doomed to Hell and an eternity in the Lake of Fire without God.

Romans 3:23: “**For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;**”

Romans 5:12: “**Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned;**”

Romans 6:23: “**For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.**”

Revelation 20:14,15: “**And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.**”

The Coverage:

God has provided a method whereby you can have coverage for your sins. This coverage was provided through the sacrifice of His Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, whose shed blood and death on the Cross serves as payment for all your past, present, and future sins. Christ died your death on the Cross and shed His blood for your sins.

Romans 10:9-13: “**That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him. For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.**”

I Corinthians 15:1-4: “**Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand; By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain. For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:**”

Ephesians 2:8,9: “**For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast.**”

When you believe the above Scriptures with all your heart, the Holy Spirit immediately baptizes you into (or identifies you with) the Body of Christ and into His death.

I Corinthians 12:13: “**For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.**”

Romans 6:3: “**Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death?**”

Once you are saved you are sealed forever and become a member of a new creation in Christ and God sees you in Christ seated at His right hand in Heavenly places.

Ephesians 1:13: “**In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,**”

Ephesians 4:30: “**And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.**”

II Corinthians 5:17: “**Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.**”

Ephesians 2:6: “**And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:**”

What the Bible teaches about your future if you are saved:

1. If you die before the Lord returns in the Rapture:

Your soul and spirit will immediately be with the Lord:

II Corinthians 5:6,8: "Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord: (For we walk by faith, not by sight:) We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord:"

Philippians 1:23,24: "For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and to be with Christ; which is far better: Nevertheless to abide in the flesh is more needful for you."

Your body will be resurrected and changed to perfection when the Lord returns in the air to take you to Heaven:

I Corinthians 15:51-53: "Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality."

I Thessalonians 4:14-18: "For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep. For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore comfort one another with these words."

2. If you are alive at the Lord's return:

You are awaiting the Lord's return at the Rapture:

Titus 2:13: "Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ;"

II Thessalonians 2:1: "Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him,"

You will be taken off the earth and given a new body as you meet the Lord in the air:

I Corinthians 15:51-53 & II Thessalonians 4:14-17 (see above).

3. You will spend eternity with God the Father, the Lord Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit in a perfect and sinless state:

Ephesians 2:7: "That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus."

What the Bible teaches about your future if you are not saved:

1. If you are not saved and die before the Lord returns in the Rapture:

Your soul and spirit will immediately be in Hell and your body will be raised on the last day to face the White Throne Judgment:

Luke 16:22-24: "And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. And he cried and said, Father

Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.”

II Peter 2:4: “For if God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast *them* down to hell, and delivered *them* into chains of darkness, to be reserved unto judgment;”

Revelation 20:11,12: “And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is *the book of life*: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.”

2. If you are not saved and alive at the Lord's return in the Rapture:

You will go into seven years of Tribulation and wrath with none of the saved left on the earth:

Matthew 24:21: “For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be.”

Romans 2:5: “But after thy hardness and impenitent heart treasures up unto thyself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous judgment of God;”

Ephesians 5:6: “Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience.”

Revelation 6:16,17: “And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb: For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?”

To become saved during the seven years will be difficult, at best, and would most likely result in your being martyred:

Revelation 6:9: “And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:”

Revelation 7:14: “And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.”

3. If you die during the seven year Tribulation, without being saved, or reject Christ and are alive at the end of the seven years, you will spend eternity, without God, tormented in the Lake of Fire:

Revelation 20:14,15: “And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.”
